Our contemplative Lenten prayer service comes from the ecumenical community of Taizé, France. The prayer is formed of several briefly worded chants sung over and over again. Repeating the chants helps to deepen our communal prayer. In between the chants we have a scripture reading followed by silence. During this silence, allow the words to sink deep into your heart. We then have time for intercessions. Please speak aloud your intercessions, and afterwards sing along with the chanted response.







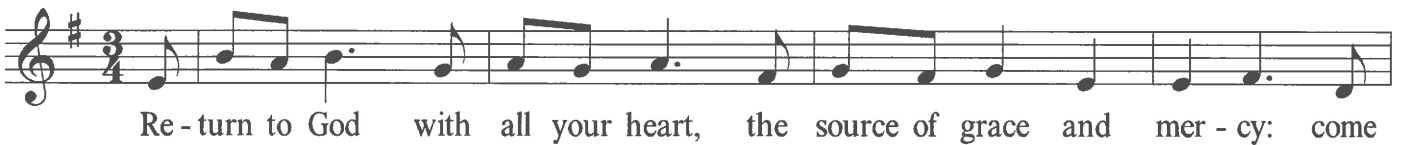


